CODE OF ETHICS FOR PLAYERS

RESPECT:

Know all the rules of their sport. Have respect for the game.

Respect and cooperate with their coaches, officials, teammates, administrators, opponents, and parents. Players are influenced by their parents' attitude and their coaches' commitment.

Players should know, understand and honor the commitments that they and their parents have made to coaches, teams, and leagues.

Respect equipment and playing sites. Do not destroy or steal anything, and properly dispose of any trash.

Expect to be treated fairly and with respect from all involved.

Behave properly at away games in other towns. One is representing their team and, more importantly, their town.

SPORTSMANSHIP:

Respect for other teams players and coaches. The need to greet/hand shakes at the end of the game.

INVOLVEMENT:

Always try their best to be a good <u>player</u> and <u>person</u> interacting with others. Lead by example, both players and coaches.

Do not show off, talk trash, or taunt anyone (players, referees, coaches).

Players need to be involved with the game and stay in the designated area for the team next to the coach...

INFLUENCE:

It's only a game; play to enjoy the game and to enjoy life.

Respect team and league rules on the field. Expect coaches, parents, fans, game officials, and administrators to provide an environment where they can learn their sport, be safe, and have fun.
